To Whom it May Concern,

On the evening of February 9th,2019 at approximately 1745 I went on my daily walk. Always same route southbound on Westside of Haist rd. While walking on sidewalk approached female and large dog at 1124 Haist rd. She was standing on sidewalk with her dog on the boulevard relieving himself. He was on a leash. When I approached dog lunged a me and bit my left hand. The female tried to hold himback and unable to do so lunged again at my left thigh. I was unable to weightbear and felt very lightheaded so she helped me to her front step and asked to me wait outside until she locked the dog up. She then proceeded to escort me inside her home and removed my glove to find large bleeding laceration on my left ring finger. The wound on my left thigh was unable to examine because of location and did not want to lower my pants. She then proceeded to give me a ride home (1 block). Asked her about shots for the dog, she informed me that he had them. I know it was a large dog but not made aware of species until constable informed me it is a Mastiff.

905-735-1552 OR 1-888-222-0568 NOTICE TO MUZZLE Pursuant to the Corporation of the Town of Pelham By-Law No. 97-2010 This is to inform you that an officer has reason to believe that on your dog has butten a person. Description of dog: Every owner shall not permit the dog to be on any streets or in any public place or any other place that is not owned or controlled by the owner unless the dog is on a substantial chain or leash not exceeding 1.5m in length and (1)muzzled in a manner that will not cause injury to the dog or interfere with its vision or respiration, but will prevent the dog from biting another animal or human - Sec. 8 (d)(1) At all times while the dog is on the premises owned or controlled by such person, keep the dog securely confined (2)indoors or in an enclosed pen or other structure, of minimum size five feet by ten feet, capable of preventing the entry of children and other animals and adequately constructed to prevent the dog from escaping - Sec. 8 (d)(2) (3)Conspicuously display a sign on his/her premises warning that there is a dangerous dog on the property - Sec. 8 (d)(3) So confine said dog that allows persons who have lawful entry onto the premises of the dog owner to have such entry (4)without fear of attack by said dog - Sec. 8 (d)(4) Allow an officer to inspect such pen or other structure or to make whatever inquiry is deemed necessary to ensure (5)compliance with the provisions of this by-law - Sec. 8 (d)(5) Notify the poundkeeper immediately if a dangerous dog is loose, unconfined, has attacked another animal or human (6)or has died or has been sold or given away. If the dog has been sold or given away the owner or harbourer shall provide the poundkeeper with the name, address, and telephone number of the new owner - Sec. 8 (d)(6) Failure to comply with the above notice will result in fines or a summons to Court and/or a hearing under the Dog Owners Liability Act where a judge may place more restrictions on the dog or order it destroyed. Dear Nancy,

I would like to appeal the muzzle order that we received on February 12, 2019 from the Welland and District Humane Society. The order was issued after an incident involving my dog and a female pedestrian on February 9, 2019. I had just returned to my house and was letting my dog go the washroom at the hydro pole located at the end of my driveway. My dog was on his leash at this time. The female pedestrian approached my dog from behind and without asking or saying anything reached down to pet my dog. My dog instinctively defended itself. I immediately took my dog in the house and secured it and then offered assistant to the female. I even drove the female to her house. A short time after this the female's husband came to my house and knocked on the door. My 15 year old son answered the door and was startled to see the male standing holding my vehicle snow brush in a threatening manner. The man then stated where's the dog, I'm going to kill it. After the man left I then contacted the Police as the situation had grown and with my husband out of the country I did not feel safe. The police came and took a report. The officer indicated that he would, as per protocol, have to notify the SPCA. On February 12, 2019 the officer from the SPCA attended my house and stated that he spoke with the female involved and then provided me with the muzzle order. The officer did not look at my dog, nor did he ask me any questions regarding the incident. I do not feel that there was any type of investigation, that the officer only took the female's side of the story. My dog has never been aggressive towards another person or animal before.

I do not feel that this one incident should result in my dog being labelled as a vicious dog. We do not let the dog run around in public without a leash as many people do. Any dog that is approached from behind by a stranger could and most likely would have a similar reaction.

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM BY-LAW #5001(2019)

Being a by-law to adopt, ratify and confirm the actions of the Council at its special meeting held on the 29th day of April 2019.

WHEREAS Section 5 (3) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, Chapter M.25, as amended, provides that, except if otherwise authorized, the powers of Council shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient that the actions of the Council as herein set forth be adopted, ratified and confirmed by by-law;

NOW THEREFORE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) (a) The actions of the Council at its meeting held on the 29th day of April, 2019, including all resolutions or motions approved, are hereby adopted, ratified and confirmed as if they were expressly embodied in this by-law.
 - (b) The above-mentioned actions shall not include:
 - (I) any actions required by law to be taken by resolution, or
 - (II) any actions for which prior Ontario Municipal Board approval is required, until such approval is obtained.
- (2) The Mayor and proper officials of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the abovementioned actions and to obtain approvals where required.
- (3) Unless otherwise provided, the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and the Clerk to affix the seal of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham to all documents necessary to give effect to the above-mentioned actions.
- (4) THAT this by-law shall come into force on the day upon which it is passed.
