• Section 7.4 (f) to allow a minimum side yard of 0.6 meters whereas the by-law requires 9.0 meters.

Public Works has the following comments;

 Public Works have concerns regarding the reduced side yard for drainage purposes.

Public Works has the following conditions;

That a comprehensive overall lot grading plan be submitted to the satisfaction
of the Director of Public Works. The grading plan is to show overland drainage
routes on the property, paying particular attention to how the reduced side yard
will affect drainage and demonstrating how the property will drain around the
north property line. Drainage is not permitted to adversely affect neighbouring
properties.
