Dear Ms Bozzato,

Regarding our telephone discussion today 25 August 2020. My previous letter to the Committee of Adjustment on April 15 2020 included my concern and that of my wife regarding a magnificent Tulip tree at the junction of John Street and Stella Street. Recently Fonthill has lost a number of old trees which were removed without much discussion. Niagara on the Lake and Toronto have controls regarding tree removal and we believed that the town of Pelham had some protection concerning trees such as Tulip trees.

We attended previous hearings of the Committee of Adjustment when this was discussed and they asked that the builder have the opinion of an arborist and to do everything in order to protect this particular Tulip tree, which is over one hundred feet high. Whilst passing by the tree recently I see three marks in red on the trunk and questioned did this indicate that the tree was going to be removed.

I have discussed this Councillor Hildebrand who I believe has discussed this with two members of the Town of Pelham staff. We really hope that this tree can remain where it has for the 55 years we have lived on Stella St.
